### Sailing Race

- Inside the gunwale.
- Can the crew sit on the gunwale during the competition to lean out?
- Yes but with the legs inside the boat.

### Navigation race

- We are not sure to understand the functioning of the event. Is it the number of the buoy or the course to steer to be given at the briefing
- You have to find the assigned buoy at the angle from the true wind. The angle of the true wind at the time of the mooring of the buoys will be displayed on the comittee boat.
- What will be the time limit?
- Timed event.
- Is it just the heading or the speed must be measured as well?
- The buoys will be very small and hardly visible: to find your course and estimate the distance, measuring your speed can help.

### Man Overboard

- When it is said that the oars should be retracted after 10 seconds. Does this mean that they should not touch the water anymore, or must they be fully retracted into the boat?
- fully inside the gunwale.

### Oars and Sail Race

- The expression "Change of propulsion within 2 lengths of the course marks", does it mean that we have 2 boat lengths to drop the sails and start rowing?
- You have up to two boat lengths after rounding the buoy to pass from sailing to rowing.
