## **3/Object**

*Les rencontres internationales des jeunes marins Dunkerque 2011* is a gathering designed to:

- Fostering a sense of initiative and responsibility.
- Transmission of knowledge.
- Valuing youth inclusion.
- Promoting the region Nord Pas de Calais.

For visitors:

- Promoting the practice of traditional sailing.

## **4/Regulations**

The competitions are governed by the international sailing legal regulations, supplemented and modified by any instructions of *Les rencontres internationales des jeunes marins Dunkerque 2011*.

Only documents and written notes prescribed by the chairman or board have official status.

## **5/Program and schedules**

The crew will host from July 13, 2011. The opening ceremony will be held on July 13, 2011 from 17 to 19 hours.

The closing ceremony will be held on July 17, 2011 at 12:00 at the Centre Regional de Voile.

### **General:**

Meals in the morning and evening will be taken in the premises of the University Restaurant (RU).

*Dinner:* from 19:30 to 21:30

The lunch will be in the form of sandwiches taken near the competition site or on board of gigs near sitesde competition or on board.

## **6/Embarcations**

This event is open only to 1796 Bantry bay gigs.

The boats must meet the criteria set out in the specifications for the Défi Jeunes Marins.

For safety and compulsory boat equipment , refer to page 7.

on launching site or in the accomodation site , each crew will prepare his boat as it will be used during the contest, in accordance with the boat equipment containst (page 7)and will be weighted a first time (trailer, boat ans complete equipment). After launching, the trailer alone will be weighed in order to check the weight of the gig.

The organisation will then proceed to ballastthe gigs if necessary, so that all the gigs are of a similary weight to ensure a fair and equitable competition.

## **7/Crew**

Each crew will consist of at least 10 people aged 15-30 years on the 13 July 2011, and at most 20 people.

### During the various events:

Each crew will consist of 13 people including at least 10 youths aged 15 to 30 years, and at least 3 women. At most 3 people will be aged over 30 years on the 13 July 2011.

### Composition of the crew during the tests:

10 rowers including at least 3 women.

2 crew helping to maneuver: one at the front, one at the rear and 1 skipper.

**At least May 31, 2011, teams must provide the organizer, the accreditation list (Appendix 1), the parantal authorizations for the under 18 years (appendix 3) and a digital passport photo of each crew member to return by mail: [ddavoli@aaedk.org](mailto:ddavoli@aaedk.org) (See description in Appendix 1)**

## **8/Inscription**

Bookings are open to any longboat (yole de Bantry) and will close on 31/12/2010.

The application will be registered on the date of receipt of a deposit of 300 euros per gig. This will be refunded upon arrival.

The organizing committee of *Rencontres internationales des jeunes marins Dukerque 2011* keeps authority on the participation of a boat.

The costs borne by the organization of international meetings of young sailors Dunkirk 2011 are:

• moving skiffs and crew.

**Less than 250 km: 150 €**

**250 kilometers to 500: 300 €**

**Over 500 km: 500 €**

• Breakfast and evening meals from 13/07/11 to Sunday 17/07/11 noon.

• The collective accommodation of 13/07/11 to 18/07/2011 at noon.

Support:

Each team will have a semi-rigid tent (garden type) of 50 square meters with floor, lighting and power, as well as tables and chairs.

Each team must bring: sleeping (sleeping bag and bed or mattress).

Modules showers and toilets will be installed on the accommodation village.

Each team must have an insurance policy to cover his equipment and a liability to others.

A insurance certificate will be sent to the organization no later than May 31, 2011 with the accreditation form of crew (Annex 1), and a copy of the license FVA.

The organization for its part will cover the insurance covering the whole event.

Admission:

Admission to participate does not become final until the longboat and his crew have met all the criteria required.

For cancellations after 1 January 2011 the deposit of 300 euros will be retained by the organization and will be distributed in proportion to the cost of moving crews.

## **9/ Recognition Marks**

all the gigs will wear their regional and *Rencontres internationales des jeunes marins* flags, except during the jackstay transfert.

on the Saturday, the event take place in the harbour area, be careful crossing low bridges.

## **10/ safety and navigation equipment.**

The following equipment will be permanently on board of each gig :

- \* Floorings.
- \* Complete rigging and sails.
- \* A lifejacket for each crew member.
- \* 10 oars.
- \* Two boathooks.
- \* A rudder including : rudder, tiller or steering sector, or steering oar instead of a rudder.
- \* Two bailers, two buckets and a bilge pump.
- \* A flag pole with national flag for foreign boats or regional flags for the french gigs and the event flag.
- \* A portable VHF operable.
- \* A towing rope of 30 meters in length and 12mm in diameter.
- \* A heaving line of at least 30 meters long equipped with a monkey fist unweighted.
- \* Mooring warps : 2 lines of 6 meters and 2 lines of 12 meters.
- \* An anchor with 10m chain.
- \* A mooring line of 30 meters which can also act as the tow line.
- \* Legal boat equipment under clause 240 for a coastal shipping for french boats, regulations of the country of origin for foreigners boats.

## **11/ Committees**

### **Organizing Committee Appointments:**

Its mission is the general organization of appointments, the media coverage of the event, awards ceremony and holding receptions.

### **Race Committee**

Its mission is to organize sports events, including vessel monitoring and control of the sporting event.

### **Jury**

Its mission is the creation of a final jury, charged with assuring the sporting event.

## **12/Skippers meetings**

A meeting of all the skippers (compulsory attendance) will be held every morning at 8 o'clock in the Restaurant Universitaire (RU) during breakfast.

## **13/ Instructions modifications**

### Display on land:

The amendments amend the instructions will be posted on the official board.

### On the water

Endorsements can be made on the water. The L flag will be hoisted and the information will be transmitted within earshot and transmitted by VHF channel 77. It is the responsibility of each boat to come within earshot or ensure they understand the endorsement on the UHF.



## 15/Ranking

Each event will result in a ranking from first to last.

**The first scores 1 point**

**The 2nd 2 points**

**3rd 3 points**

**The 4th 4points**

The first has scored the least points.

And so on up to 1 point per place next.

## **19. Life in the community and Sustainable Development**

For the sake of environmental protection, it is requested that each team member to bring a water bottle (1L), which can be filled with water at the place of accommodation or restaurant, no bottle water on board or on-site competitions during the event.

The organization will provide bags for waste recovery and each crew is required to separate their waste and back on shore to put it in the proper containers at the place of mooring, cigarettes butts or other Chewing gum should not be thrown overboard or on the ground. Sorting methods will be clearly explained by billboards in the area of these.

These instructions are also valid in the accommodation village.

When using the showers and toilets each person is asked to fight against waste and reduce its water consumption and energy production (gas and electricity) by limiting the time of shower and toilet and turning off the lights as often as possible in the toilets and tents. Also during the various breakfast and meals, it is asked not to waste food and beverage using too much.

Thank you for taking these recommendations into account, to be an eco-citizen it is good for mankind and it is good for our planet!  
It is also asked to each registered person as not to carry or use illicit substances in accordance with applicable laws on French territory.

On the accomodation village the respect of others is paramount and to this end it is asked to make no more noise from 23.00, the place will be guarded and all outbursts observed may result in penalties and sanctions.

Coming from the A25 Lille / Dunkerque

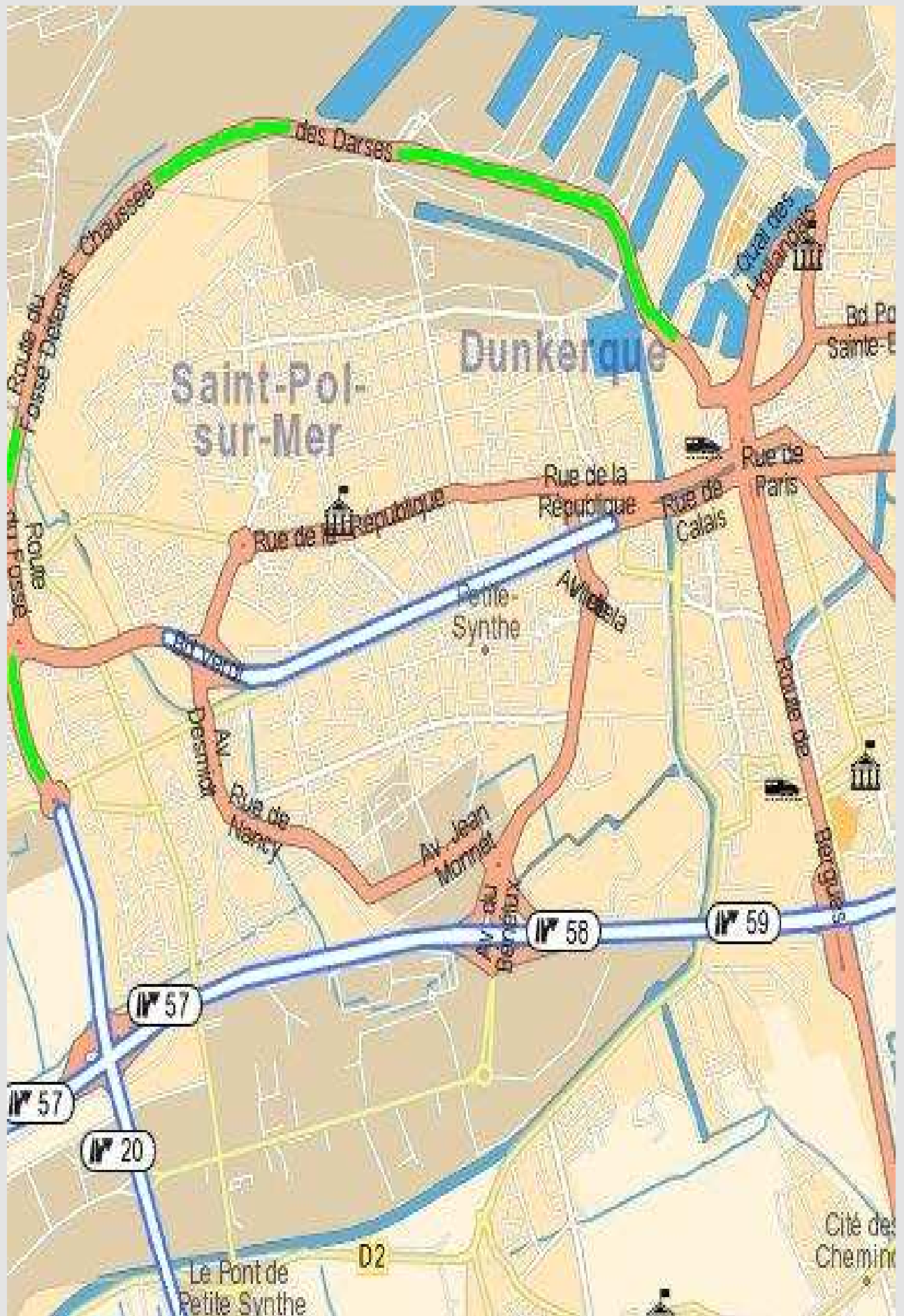
Stay on the A25 which becomes D625
